Latest arrangements of the “Video mode Competition”

In response to the change in teaching arrangements for this academic year, the Organiser has revised the submission period of the “Video Mode Competition”. Details are as follows:

Category	Video Submission Period (1 st revision)	Video Submission Period (2 nd revision)	Result announcement date(2 nd revision)
“Dance for Health”	16 – 20 May	4 – 6 July	8 July
Solo/Duet/Trio	16 – 20 May	4 – 6 July	1 August
DanceSport	16 – 20 May	4 – 6 July	1 August
Group Dance	4 – 8 July	3 – 5 August	31 August

As the Organiser needs to sort a lot of videos and scoring documents in a short period of time, participating schools must cooperate with the following arrangements:

1. If participating schools of Chinese Dance, Western Dance, Oriental Dance, Modern dance, Children Dance, Jazz & Street Dance need to change the dance information which will be printed on the scoring document (including dance name, country/tribe and whether to apply for Choreography Award), they have to submit the information in Google form before the specified date, and then visit the HKSDA website to check whether the dance information on the fixtures is correct before the specified date.

Details are as follows:

Category	Deadline for changing dance information	Period for checking the fixture	Date for checking the updated fixture
Solo/Duet/Trio	27 June	29 June – 6 July	8 July
Group Dance	27 July	29 July – 5 August	9 August

If other information (such as the number of dancers) needs to be changed, the school must fill out the “Video Mode Competition Information Form”, and it is not necessary to inform the Association before submitting the video.

2. When school representatives submit videos to our studio, the secretariat will give priority to check videos with earlier scoring periods.
3. Before submitting the video, 2 or more computers must be used to ensure the video can be opened and the audio & video are synchronised. The Organiser will not accept the participating schools to replace the video after the deadline.

The Organiser will closely monitor the development of the epidemic, continue to review the competition arrangements, and make relevant announcements in a timely manner.
